#### **Our Region's Complex Housing Issues**

You can't turn on the news or read the paper without hearing about the shortage of affordable housing in our region and beyond. In 2022, the Cheshire County rental housing availability rate was 0.6%. Compare that to 5%, which is considered a healthy rate\*. Our lack of housing has far-reaching effects on families and individuals in our region, including a serious negative impact on overall health and well-being.

#### **Innovative Partnerships Tackle Affordable Housing**

MUW has implemented an effective and efficient collaborative approach to solving key challenges in our communities. Here's a quick look at two coalitions helping people secure housing in our area:

#### **Cheshire County Emergency Housing Collaborative (CCEHC)**

• Established in 2020 with funding from MUW, CCEHC members Southwestern Community Services (SCS), Monadnock Center for Violence Prevention (MCVP), and Hundred Nights, Inc. work together to assist homeless and housing-insecure individuals and families in obtaining stable housing. #### The Monadnock Resource Alliance (MRA)

 Founded by MUW and the NH Community Loan Fund, the MRA acknowledges that there is no one solution or entity that will solve our housing crisis. It brings together local nonprofits, businesses, government, economic
