Impact Monadnock received **CARES Act** funding through **Childcare Aware of New**



The **Monadnock Farm Share Program** is now accepting applications for a reduced vegetable CSA (community supported agriculture). This program was developed for limited income residents of the Monadnock Region. To be eligible for this program your annual household income must not exceed \$50,000/year.
