




## An Update from MUW President Liz LaRose

Dear Friends of MUW,

I'm pleased to share with you MUW's 2021 [Community Impact Report](#)! This report highlights collective impact work in our three focus areas of children, education, and financial stability.



Collective Impact describes an intentional way of working together and sharing information for the purpose of solving a complex problem. Rather than working in isolation, we partner with the community, unite people and organizations around shared goals, mobilize volunteers to be social change agents, and leverage investments through measurable strategies and aligning of resources.

Over the next few weeks, I'll be highlighting data from the Community Impact report from each of our focus areas. This week, I'd like to share with you the work we are doing in the [children's focus area](#).

Here are just a few of our successes in 2021:

- 848 children aged (0-5) (compared to 46 in 2020), across 34 towns participated in enrichment programs such as playgroups, art classes, cooking classes, and more through the [Monadnock Alliance for Families](#).
- The [Southwestern Community Services Dental Screening Program](#) resumed after an 18-month hiatus and was able to provide 64 children with dental screenings and preventative dental services in just the first four months of the school year. This program is now managed through [Head Start](#).

- The [Monadnock Region After School Collective](#) provided safe, educational settings for 938 children and had an 80% reduction in behavior incidents.
