Henry is a smart, thoughtful four-year old boy who is living his best life. But not very long ago that wasn't the case. Because his family could not adequately care for him when he was a baby, Henry was placed with Kayla, a compassionate foster mom who was committed to giving him the attention he needed to grow and flourish.

At two years old, Henry had no speech at all. Unsurprisingly, he also had significant sleep problems. Kayla enrolled Henry in the Southern New Hampshire Services (SNHS) Hillsboro Child Development Center, which provides quality childcare and child development resources, to seek assistance with Henry's challenges.

Over the next two years, a specialist from the public schools met with Henry at the Center for speech therapy. Kayla also enlisted a therapist to help Henry with his sleep problems. The collaboration between Kayla and Henry's therapist, specialists, and teachers has been very productive. The staff at SNHS have noticed a significant improvement in Henry's speech and his sleep patterns have improved. Best of all, Henry has made a lot of friends and learned many new things.
