While she was looking for work, single mom Amy desperately needed to find affordable, high-quality childcare and preschool programs for her three children. The Winchester Learning Center (WLC) provides a warm, supportive, and stimulating environment. They focus on the individual needs of each child and their family. Amy's children were enrolled with financial assistance from the NH Childcare Tuition Assistance program and a Monadnock United Way scholarship.
