# Monadnock United Way is dedicated to creating opportunities for everyone in the Monadnock Region.

We envision a United community where all are cared for and thriving. We're doing this by focusing on children, education, and financial stability.

With your help, we have made great strides, and by Teaming Up for Tomorrow, we can continue to create opportunities for all to flourish!

- We still have third-highest rate of child maltreatment in NH
   The five agencies of the Monadnock Alliance for Families provide opportunities for families to access home visits, parent education, and programming to promote optimal child development and strengthen parenting. Last year, 857 children and families received services through this collaboration.
- 9.9% of our residents live at or below the federal poverty line
   Through MUW's investment in the Monadnock Food Pantries
   Collective, 2,854 individuals received basic foods and fresh produce across 8 local food pantries last year.
- 14.9% of our residents face housing instability
   MUW invests in the Cheshire County Emergency Housing
   Collaborative to support residents facing housing insecurity
   or homelessness. In 2023, the initiative helped 412 people.
