IN 2024 \$1.4 MILLION WAS INVESTED IN OUR NEIGHBORS. ALL DONATIONS STAY IN OUR LOCAL REGION- HELPING YOU AND YOUR NEIGHBORS.

Cheshire County Emergency Housing Collaborative served 305 clients with safe, clean emergency housing. 58 (19%, up from 4.8% in 2023) participated in educational programs, and 188 (62%) engaged in housing-focused case plans.

Monadnock Alliance for Families reached 694 families with home visiting services, including 318 new clients (46%). 1,521 clients accessed parent education and engagement services, for a total of 2,215 families served.

Monadnock Region Afterschool Collective enrolled 1,217 children. 98% of parents said it reduced stress, and 92% said it improved financial stability.

Monadnock Food Pantries Collective recorded 44,664 member/client visits and provided 68,227 meal equivalents.

Monadnock United Way gave financial aid to 4 child care centers, serving 193 children.
