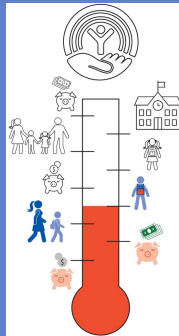

Dear Friends of MUW,

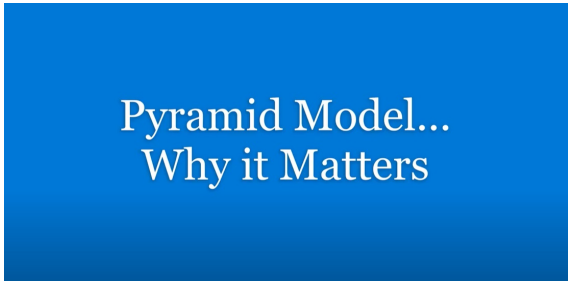
You may be surprised to learn that preschool children get expelled at a rate three times higher than students in elementary and high school. And the stakes are higher: a child who gets expelled from preschool may cause the loss of employment of a parent, causing further strain on the family.

Luckily, MUW and our agencies are implementing an evidence-based strategy and will help break the cycle of problem behaviors in preschoolers. It's called The Pyramid Model and through a grant from the state, it is now being implemented at the following centers around the region:

- Keene Day Care Center
- The Children's Learning Center at Cheshire Medical Center
- The Child Development Center at Keene State College
- Rise for baby and family
- Keene Family YMCA
- Walpole Village School
- Home Away from Home, Walpole

The Pyramid Model is a framework for supporting early childhood professionals to promote young children's social emotional learning. Social emotional learning is the process through which children learn to understand and manage emotions, set and achieve goals, feel and show empathy for others, establish and maintain positive relationships, and make responsible decisions.

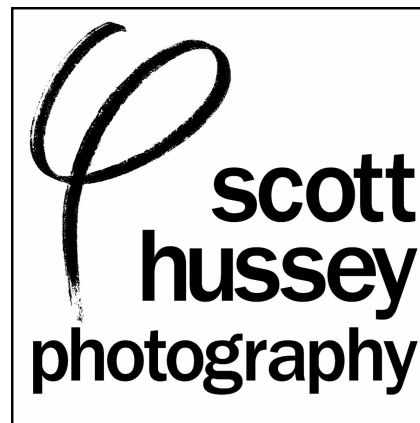
