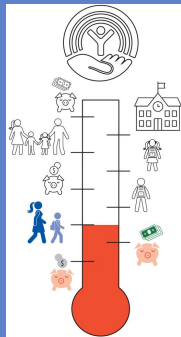
Dear Friends of MUW,

Did you know that in our region 1 out of 4 of our residents live in poverty, while in the rest of New Hampshire, the rate is 1 in 5? It's a shocking statistic that leaves many of our individuals and families vulnerable to food insecurity and homelessness.

MUW and our agencies are doing something about this negative trend by using a Collective Impact approach and working with collaborations like the Cheshire County Emergency Housing Collaborative and the Monadnock Food Pantries Collective.

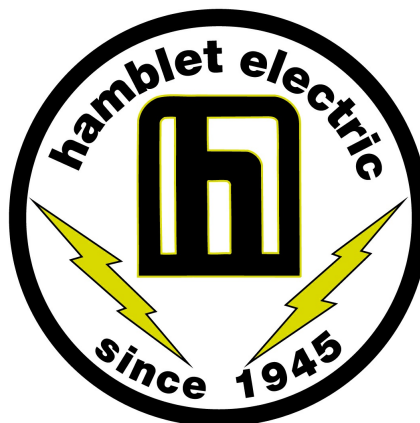

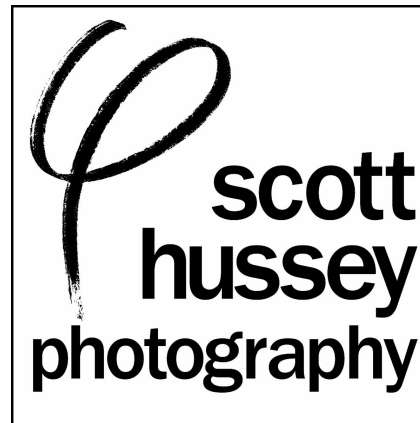
