- The ENTERPRISE AWARD is presented to company and employee groups conducting community engagement efforts with an exceptional level of creativity and enthusiasm. The 2023 recipient is C&S Wholesale Grocers. Their highly effective workplace campaign which raised \$187,979, a 23% increase from the previous year culminated in a company-wide picnic that brought employees together for a fun-filled afternoon while giving back to the local community in the process.

The 2023 recipient is **Savings Bank of Walpole**, who has partnered with MUW for many years through robust workplace campaigns; volunteering through the Loaned Employee program and the annual Day of Caring; and advocating for family-friendly workplace policies through the Impact Monadnock Business Ambassadors.
- The TRAILBLAZER AWARD goes to a local group in a new partnership with MUW that demonstrates commitment to being a strong community partner in their year-round efforts to engage with and support our community. The 2023 Recipient is the Hinsdale Adverse Childhood Experiences Resource Team (ACERT). This program is based on the premise that children regularly exposed to stressful, traumatic situations are more likely to experience negative impact to their development. When first responders are called to a home, ACERT Team members engage with the family to ensure the children are offered support and services to help mitigate the impact of trauma exposure.
