#### What is IMBA?

Impact Monadnock is MUW's signature impact initiative which seeks to improve outcomes for all children and families. IMBA members from several area organizations strive to educate the local business community about the importance of early childhood education and family-friendly policies in the workplace. They make compelling presentations to organizations such as local Lions Clubs, Rotary Clubs, and Chamber groups, sharing the benefits of adopting child- and family-friendly policies. The ambassadors also serve as a resource for other communities and United Way organizations.

#### **Impact and Successes**

IMBA helps to further Impact Monadnock's goal to strengthen early learning opportunities in our community. Here are two examples:

 Most families and businesses in the Monadnock Region are well aware of the dire need for more quality childcare. IMBA fully supported the effort to secure a \$1 million grant for the Childhood Expansion Project for Keene State College and MUW to train current and new early childhood educators.
