A couple of weeks ago we shared a link to MyFreeTaxes to help low-moderate income tax filers claim refunds and credits essential to their financial stability. Today we'll look at another way your generous donations contribute to financial stability in the Monadnock Region: Tuition assistance to ensure families in need have steady access to affordable, high-quality childcare and preschool programs.



The Growing Cost of Child Care

In New Hampshire, the average tuition price per year for a preschooler is over \$14,000 and the average tuition price for an infant is over \$17,000*! The rising cost of child care, in addition to rising housing and food prices often make child care cost prohibitive for many families. In these instances, MUW's tuition assistance program becomes a life-line, enabling families to achieve financial stability and peace of mind knowing that their children are safe and well-cared for.
