### Help Children Thrive, Parents Work, and Careers Blossom

### **Dear MUW Supporters**,

Nothing motivates or inspires everyone connected to MUW more than seeing the real impact of programs that support what we care about most – our region's children, education for success and career growth, and the financial stability of families. Today we're excited to share two impactful and interconnected programs that do just that: Monadnock Region Afterschool Collective (MRAC) and Monadnock Region Afterschool Partnership Project (MRAPP).

#### **Enhancing the lives of Children and Families**

In 2019, MRAC formalized partnerships among afterschool programs in our region. The collective seeks to empower, support, and sustain afterschool collaborations that lead to positive social, health, and educational outcomes for children in the Monadnock Region.

MRAC shared the following successes in 2024:

- 1,217 youth were served in 12 area towns
- 91% of afterschool attendees felt safe, supported, and confident they 'belonged'
- 92% of parents believe having a child in the program improved their family's financial stability

# **Greater Access to Childcare Through Workforce Development**

The MRAPP initiative:

- Supports internship placements in local afterschool programs
- Creates career awareness and pathways for young people
- Addresses staffing shortages in area afterschool programs

Since launching, over 20 interns in afterschool programs across the region have contributed more than 1,500 hours of direct service to children and families.

The feedback from participants has been fantastic! 95% of interns report satisfaction with the experience and 100% of site directors report that MRAPP interns improved program quality and adult-to-student ratios. Thanks to this support, many sites were able to increase enrichment offerings afterschool and serve more students than staffing levels previously allowed.
