First, let me add my sincere thanks to those expressed by our United We All Win campaign co-chairs in last week's newsletter. Your generosity and community spirit enabled us to raise just over \$25,000 on GivingTuesday. Those funds count towards this year's campaign goal and it is crucial we reach our goal this year!



We all know that times are very challenging right now, not only for individuals and families but also for our partners. The agencies who provide critical services to the most needy feel the pinch, too. Here's what Sarah Harpster, Executive Director of <u>The Community Kitchen</u> shared with me recently:

"The cost of food has risen over 13% since 2021, and over 21% since 2019. We are seeing greater community need as more families are unable to afford to feed themselves. And inflation has reduced the ability of many of our donors to provide as much support to the charities they care about. Other operational costs are also on the rise."

Melissa Gallagher, Executive Director of <u>The Grapevine Family</u> <u>& Community Resource Center</u> in Antrim adds:

"We have observed a marked increase in calls and walk-ins for people who need help with basic needs such as food, fuel, shelter, and
