NH Early Childhood Region 1 received grant funding from the Preschool Development Grant (PDG) to provide a Practice-Based Coaching (PBC) Institute with a lens of the Five Protective Factors as identified in the Strengthening Families Framework.

We are seeking 10-12 experienced practitioners from across our region and drawn from all sectors including: schools, early childhood care and education, family supports, and other community partners to participate.

A participant's total commitment is from January 2022-December 2022 and includes:

Practice-Based Coaching Training

4 sessions via video conferencing 3:00-5:00 pm (Jan. 20 & 27, Feb. 3 & 10)

Strengthening Families Online Training

13 hours to be completed on own schedule by March 1

Monthly 1-hour Professional Learning Community via video conferencing

March through December

Individual Coach meetings with Coaching Coordinator

Quarterly and as needed

Time to coach 2 individuals within your organization

Approximately 4 hours a month per individual

Organizations may choose to use some of the \$10,000 stipend to compensate staff members who are coaching for time outside of their normal work hours to participate.
